Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •KEEP IN MIND THAT SINCE MANY THE JUDGES ARE 1 DAY ONLY, IT OPEN UP A LOT MORE POSSABILITES TO MOVE DOGS AROUND TO EVEN OUT THE SCHEDULE WITHOUT CONFLICTING WITH THE NEXT DAY'S ASSIGNMENTS. •Ring 7 needs to stay on time, but they're schedule is slightly more crammed than I usually write. If they fall behind, try and move dogs so they can catch up. If Ring 7 is late at the end of the day, then Ring 2 will be pushed late then BIS would be pushed late. •Ring 6 needs to time their lunch to coincide with show 1 SPORTING GROUP (lunch @ about 12:25-12:55). •Because of an oversite, ring 5 has a light load SAT and doesn't start until 10:15am. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Ring 1 has a late lunch (12:50-1:20). •Ring 3 has a late lunch (12:50-1:20). •Ring 5 has a late lunch (12:50-1:20). •Rings 3 & 7 should finish 20 min early. So if that goes to plan then they should be able to help even out the schedule for BIS if needed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Belgian Malinois have show 4 BREFOR show 3 breed times. • 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Ring 1 has a late lunch (12:25-12:55). •Rings 4 & 6 need to time their lunch to coincide with show 3 HOUND GROUP (lunch @ about 12:00-12:30). •Ring 2 will need to break for show 3 SPORTING GROUP (or try and work around) at about 1:35-1:50. This break is not written in. • •Ring 6 (in order to not conflict with show 3 WORKING GROUP) will need to judge some working breeds, then a few hound dogs, then come back and finish working breeds, then come back and finish hound breeds and group. •Ring 5 (in order to put HOUND GROUP at the same time as rings 4 & 6 lunch) will need to judge some sporting breeds, then judge hounds dogs and group, then come back and finish sporting breeds and group. •
